Access and Ownership

Following payment of the deposit/first instalment, students will be issued with a school-owned device and listed inclusions as part of their transition program to school. Students are able to take the device home as required to support their learning program.

To purchase the device outright from the school at the end of Year 9, all payments must be made, including the OEM fee to finalise the transfer the ownership from the school to the Parent/Carer (and student).
