

Bremer State High School Recommended Levels of Achievement 2026

To support academic success across Year 11 and 12, Bremer State High School provides a Recommended Level of Achievement (RLA) for each of the subjects available in Year 11 and 12. These are provided to inform students, parents and caregivers of the level of preparedness required to succeed in that particular subject. It is expected that students wanting to take a subject demonstrate the Recommended Level of Achievement on their Semester 1 Report Card and then maintain or improve across Semester 2.

Students wishing to be on the *Study* pathway and obtain an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) need to demonstrate their preparedness to take on the academic rigour and competitive nature of the ATAR. It is expected these students achieve at a B or higher on average across all of their subjects, as well as any relevant individual subject requirements.

Students are able to select from General Subjects, Applied Subjects, and Vocational Education and Training (VET) subjects:

General subjects are academic in nature and designed to prepare students for tertiary education. Six General Subjects are required for students on a <i>Study</i> pathway, and no more than three can be selected by students on a <i>Training</i> or <i>Work</i> pathway.
