

## Recommended levels of achievement for entry into Year 11 Subjects

The table below details the Recommended Levels of Achievement for Year 10 students progressing into Year 11. Please note that students **must demonstrate a pattern of achievement** to meet these requirements. As such, a student who achieves a 'B' in Semester 1, but a lower achievement in previous years, may not be eligible for entry to the subject selected.

- Students should read this document carefully to identify if there are requirements for the subjects they are interested in undertaking. Recommended Levels of Achievement mean that the student must have demonstrated the required level of achievement throughout previous years of study to gain admission to the subject and to be successful in that subject.
- Recommended Levels of Achievement, as specified, are supported by a range of other indicators including the student's: **attendance, effort and engagement**. All General Subjects have a requirement for semester passes during the course to allow continuation of study in the subject. A semester result of 'Needs Attention' or 'Unacceptable' will require the student to show cause why they should be considered for that subject.
- Student SET plans may be reviewed following the release of semester 2 results. Changes to student SET plans may occur following consultation with Curriculum Heads of Department.
