

# STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS

To enable students and parents to purchase requirements prior to the commencement of classes, we are providing information on stationery items to be purchased for students in the Junior and Senior School across all subject areas plus some specific requirements for particular subjects. Students are not required to purchase all of the stationery items listed below, nor are there particular brands required. Students may prefer to defer making purchases until after they have checked the specific advice of class teachers.

## Bring Your Own Device (BYOx) Program and School Computer Network

Bremer has an extensive computer network with the fastest speeds and most modern server systems available to EQ schools. Subject teachers integrate information technology into the learning program in various ways. As a result, any student who is participating in the school's Resource Scheme is supplied with an EQ computer account and an initial \$5 printing credit. Additional printing credit can be purchased through the Finance office.

In 2020 all Year 11 and 12 students and Year 7 and 8 Bremer Science Extension Pathway students will be required to participate in the BYOx program. The program requires students to bring a digital device such as a laptop or tablet to school to support their learning. Students in Years 7, 8, 9, 10 are also able to participate in the program and bring a digital device to school to support their learning.
