Dear parents and caregivers

From **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> August at 4.00pm** there will be **further easing of restrictions**.

Thank you to all our Community, for your ongoing cooperation and adherence to the latest restrictions. Your efforts have helped ensure Stage 2 restrictions will be lifted as planned.

Transitioning to [Stage 3 restrictions](#), which apply throughout the state, means we can now return to COVID normal, with the exception that masks will still be required to be worn by high school students and school staff in the 11 affected South East Queensland LGAs for at least the next two weeks.

Parents/carers and visitors are allowed on school sites, with the requirement they adhere to the ongoing direction regarding the wearing of masks.

This means masks must be worn by all adults inside school buildings but may be removed outdoors, as long as they can keep 1.5 metres apart from other people.

Assemblies and other large group activities including instrumental music groups, choirs, performances, extra curricula sporting activities, and dancing are permitted, adhering to COVID-19 health directions including wearing of masks.

Interschool sport and excursions are permitted.

Visitors and external providers including providers of extracurricular activities will now be permitted on school sites.

Masks must be worn by all visitors and external providers inside school buildings but may be removed outdoors, as long as they can keep 1.5 metres apart from other people.

Thank you for your understanding as we continue to work together during these difficult times.
