GENERAL (FOR ATAR)

Music,
Film, TV & New Media

- prerequisite: **B IN ENG OR B IN THE RELEVANT SUBJECT**

APPLIED SUBJECTS (NON ATAR)

Media Arts In Practice, Dance In Practice, Drama In Practice, Music in Practice

- prerequisites: NONE but:
You must be willing to perform MUP—must sing or play an instrument
