Bremer State High School is proud to offer the Defence School Mentor Program to further support our Defence families. In 2025, the DSM will be available on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

Defence School Mentors

The Defence School Mentor Program is delivered in partnership with schools to support the wellbeing of children of ADF members.

The program connects children with their school community and enhances the school's ability to address the impacts of the military lifestyle.

Defence provides funding to eligible schools to assist with the employment of Defence School Mentors (DSMs).

The program has 4 objectives:

- 1. Provide families with information about the school environment and the support available relevant to their child's development needs.
- 2. Support children to access school based social and emotional support, aligned to school policies.
- 3. Facilitate opportunities for children to build relationships and connections through events and other initiatives.
- 4. Raise awareness amongst the school community about the impacts of the Defence lifestyle on children and families.

Education Liaison Officers

Education Liaison Officers (EDLOs) provide an education advisory service for Defence families to:

- inform families about local schools and education systems
- connecting families with education providers and resources
- work with parents, children and teachers to manage the transition to a new school
- working with schools to ensure a supportive educational environment
- provide advice on Defence financial assistance.

EDLOs have extensive knowledge about the differences in the way states, territories and individual schools deliver education. They also understand the unique needs of Defence children.

Defence Member and Family Support

Located at RAAF Base Amberley, the Amberley Area Office team provides ADF members and families with local information and access to support and information services. It organises regular events for fulltime current serving ADF members and their Defence recognised dependants.

The team consists of Defence Social Workers, Military Support Officers, Family and Education Liaison officer and Business Support who are all available to support members and their families during their time in the region.

Education Assistance Scheme

Defence recognises that some children may experience disruption to their education each time they move for a posting.

Financial support is available to help minimise the disruption to education caused by posting.

Defence may provide assistance when a posting means that a child needs to:

- change schools
- study at a school not in the posting location
- study at a tertiary institution away from home.

Financial support available under the Education Assistance Scheme includes:

- tutoring
- tuition and boarding school allowance
- tertiary accommodation
- loss of scholarship compensation
- reunion travel.

The ADF Pay and Conditions Manual provides further details on Education assistance.

ADF Equip

The ADF Equip – Children's Group Resilience Program is a suite of facilitated workshop style sessions designed to support the social and emotional resilience and wellbeing of Defence children.

Children and young people learn age-appropriate strategies to support them to better manage the challenges associated with Defence family life through:

- activities to get to know other Defence children
- activities to improve social and emotional wellbeing
- discussion on how children and parents can access other relevant support.

There are unique programs covering 2 key topics.

- Parental Absence
- Relocation.

Defence Member and Family Support (DMFS) runs ADF Equip at least twice a year in all regions, and delivery method and location will vary.

ADF Equip sessions will be advertised in the e-newsletters and registration via Eventbrite.

SMART Program

The SMART Program series helps Defence families identify and build on their strengths, learn coping techniques, and becomes more resilient, positive and self-reliant.

The SMART Programs - KidSMART and FamilySMART - are delivered by local Defence Social Workers in small group sessions.

The Programs target challenging aspects of Defence life, such as deployment, relocation, absence from home and reunion.

Practical tips and techniques are shared, including grounding techniques, progressive muscle relaxation, changing self-talk, problem solving, and expressing emotions.

Participants will also learn how to identify when other people are having difficulty coping and how to help them.

Partner Assistance Employment Program

The Partner Employment Assistance Program (PEAP) provides funding for eligible ADF partners to access professional employment services or cover the costs of mandatory registration.

Eligibility

To be eligible for PEAP funding, applicants must:

- be a partner of a full time ADF member
- be formally recognised by Defence as a partner
- not be a full-time serving member themselves
- have geographically relocated due to a member posting to location within Australia.

Defence Childcare Program

Defence families can face challenges securing childcare when posting to a new location or changing work or care arrangements.

Defence offers a number of options to support families to access suitable childcare services.

Individual case management

Members can access individual case management (ICM) services, ensuring childcare is tailored to their circumstances. ICM support includes:

- negotiating with local childcare providers
- organising family day-care
- arranging before and after school care
- submit application for Australian Government In-Home Care Support Agency If eligible.

Defence's childcare service provider, One Tree Community Services, have specialist early learning staff who provide families with childcare service options.

Orion Lagoon

Location: Southern Cross Circuit, Springfield Central

Touted as one of the largest public lagoons in the Southern Hemisphere, Orion Lagoon is a popular place to bring the family when you are in Ipswich, to cool off on a warm day.
