Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2018, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2018 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Expanding the Literacy Hubs and associated programs to improve the reading and writing achievement of students in Years 7 to 9
- Establishing a Numeracy Hub to provide intensive support to students in Years 7 to 9
- Tracking and monitoring the performance of all students across Years 7 to 12 and implementing intervention for students that are identified as needing additional support or extension
- Continuing targeted programs for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students
- Expanding the professional learning program for teachers, focusing on school priorities
- Continuing the implementation of Positive Behaviour for Learning
- Expanding the Careers Connection Centre to increase VET pathways for students
- Implementing the P&C Student Support Services Centre to support student mental health and wellbeing
